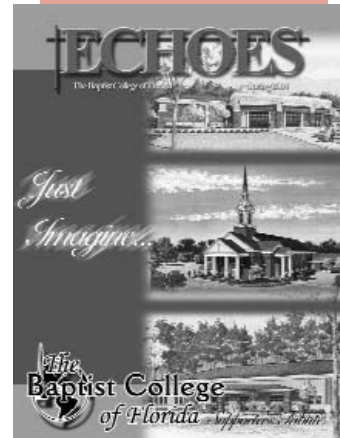

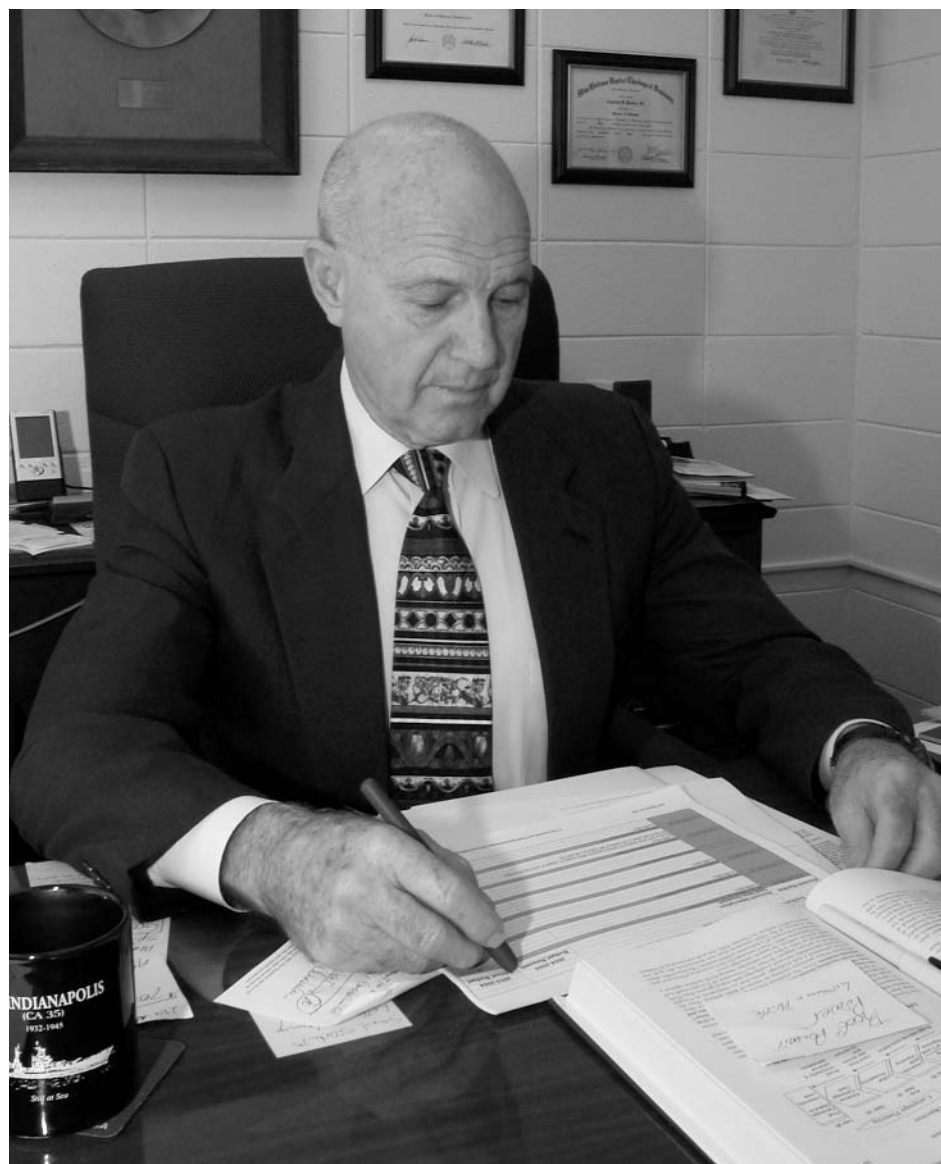

The view from the *Inside*



A long-time friend of the college, BCF's new vice president for institutional advancement chats with the editor of *Echoes* about his new found responsibilities as a member of the college's administration and what it's like to now be on the inside at BCF.

Q Mr. Parker, as the newest member of the administrative staff, what is your most significant impression of your new work?

A The first weeks have been both exciting and challenging. Perhaps the most significant impression is the quality of the students and their commitment to doing the will of God in their lives. Equally impressive is the unparalleled dedication of the faculty and staff. This institution is unlike any with which I have been associated.

Q For a number of years you have been a friend to the college. What have you seen as a

member of the administrative team that you did not see before you moved to Graceville?

A As an interested outsider I had heard how BCF could stretch a dollar and make it go further than almost anyone could imagine. Now that I am on campus I see this taking place. We have operated with very limited funds and yet we continue to turn out well prepared and deeply dedicated students who are making a difference in the world.

Q Your work as Vice President for Institutional Advancement includes many responsibilities. How are you spending the majority of

your time in these first months?

A That is an interesting question. I really did not know what all I would be overseeing but each part of my work is both challenging and rewarding. The first priority of my office is to give leadership to our capital funds program, JUST IMAGINE. This requires a great amount of time but it is of highest priority to the trustees, our president and the faculty and staff. We must raise the money needed to provide desperately needed facilities here on campus.

Q And what facilities are you speaking of?

ect. JUST IMAGINE is the campaign slogan and what we want to do. We want our friends to invest in the lives and ministry of students and to imagine with us what a difference this will make.

Q When does JUST IMAGINE begin?

A Now! As we speak our friends are beginning to receive information about the much needed improvements and they are being asked to join with us in investing in the lives of the folks whom our Lord has called. We are not asking for gifts, rather investments. Often a gift is used and there is little return. We believe whatever we do with our campus and for our students is an eternal investment.

Q How might one join in this investment?

A Any money sent for this project will be used exclusively for the renovation of Lee Chapel and the much needed buildings. One could send their investment to the college in care of Dr. Kinchen's office or they may mail the check to the office of Institutional Advancement.

Q Thank you for the interview. Is there anything else you might want to share?

A It is such a joy to serve the Lord at BCF. I believe we are going to get the new work accomplished and we will continue to prepare the finest students in the world to help Change the World with the Unchanging Gospel of Jesus Christ.

A We simply must update the R. G. Lee Chapel. We want this to be the center focus of the campus and to become a learning center and laboratory for preaching, music and visual arts. The renovation will provide state of the art media production facilities and additional seating to relieve overcrowding. The expanded and renovated facility will provide a beautiful symbol of what our school is about.

Q Are there other needs?

A Yes, two buildings for use by our students are desperately needed. One building will serve as an auditorium and the other will provide a wellness center.

Q How will the college pay for the renovation of Lee Chapel and the renovation of these buildings?

A A large part of my new work will be to join with our President and travel across our state and the adjacent states inviting friends to join us in giving to this proj-



New *Alumni* Director Announced

Tommy Smith has been named the new director of alumni affairs and church relations for BCF. Smith is a native of Jacksonville, Florida but moved to BCF in 1999 to earn a degree in theology.

A 1988 graduate of Ed White Senior High School, Smith attended Jacksonville Apprenticeship Training Trust where he became a licensed plumber in 1995.

While working in the field he began to teach Sunday School for the college and career group at Hillcrest Baptist Church in 1996. Through this experience and discipleship from a lay member of the church, Smith began to feel a call to ministry.

He first visited BCF in 1998 on the recommendation of a friend and the rest is history. "I just knew this is where God was calling me," explains Smith.

The new director has maintained a full schedule since coming to BCF. He continued in ministry serving as youth minister for churches in Dothan, Alabama and joining the BCF staff full-

time in 2002 as director of student activities.

He was later appointed the assistant to the vice president for Institutional Advancement before taking the new director of alumni affairs and church relations position in March of this year.

"As a student I have really enjoyed the closeness with the professors and the their talents to communicate to us as students what will help us to be effective in ministry as well as the lifetime friendships that have been built with my fellow students," explained Smith.

He says he is excited to have the opportunity to continue working at BCF, "My challenge now is in seeing what the Lord wants to do with this office and His people." "I know that we can build upon the relationships that are already in place so that we can

face the future together."

Charles Parker, vice president for institutional advancement, echoes this sentiment, "We are extremely fortunate to have one of our own alumni available who loves the school and is totally committed to developing a program to re-connect our alumni to the college."

Smith says he is up for the task, "I really believe we can make a difference in the life of our alumni if we put them back at the top of our priority list." "Where would be without the treasured assets of students and alumni who make us who we are?"

Smith will receive a Bachelor of Arts degree in Theology from BCF in the May 2004 ceremony. He plans to continue his education in pursuit of a MBA at Troy State University in Dothan.
